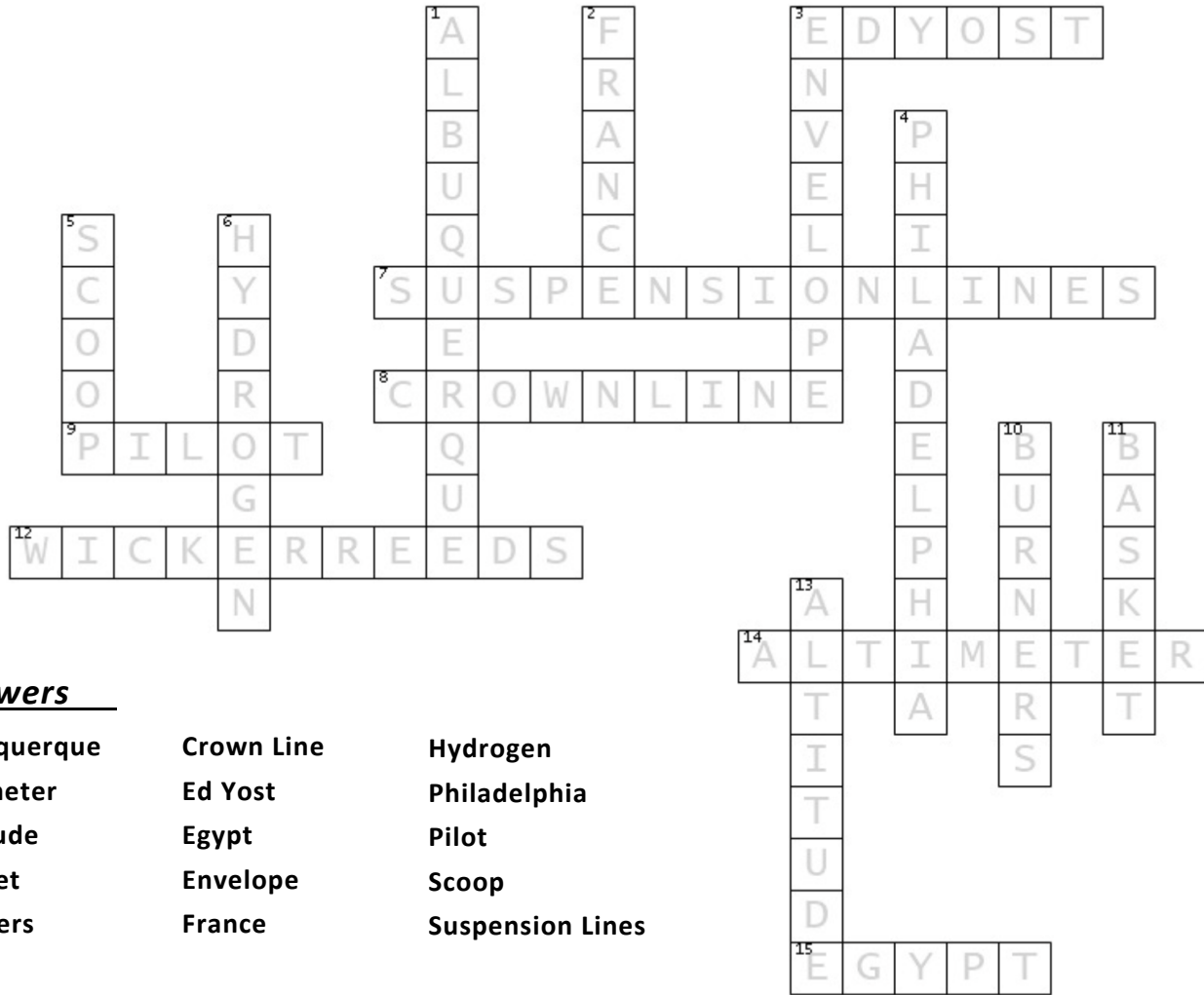


## Crossword Puzzle
